## SERVICE OF BEGINNINGS

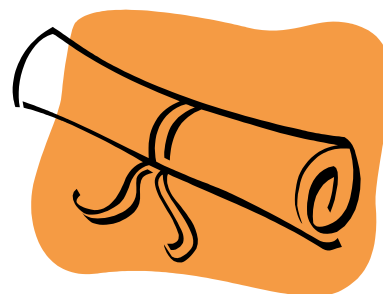

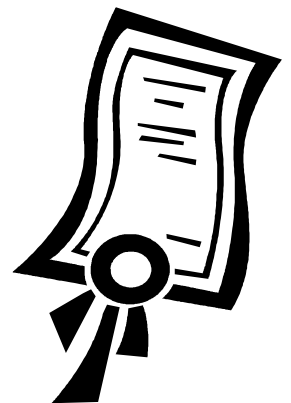
