Chatted about school structure and scheduling. Interested to learn that the district education office determines the school day and also the scheduling of students. They run 8 periods per day from 8.50am to 4.05pm. Lunch is during a normal period time either 4th or 6th period in the day. Athletics is offered as a subject in the senior school while PE is part of the grade 9 (freshman) programme. The athletics periods are programmed by sport eg baseball,football,soccer,volleyball...and are taken by a qualified coach who is also a staff member.

The Athletics Director has oversight of the programmes for all sports and a girls athletics director is 2IC.

As this is a State School all costs are met by the state for books, sports uniforms, and gear. Students may buy lunch at the cafeteria or some may be on a free lunch programme depending on financial circumstances. Grade 12 students are free to go off campus for lunch and some grade 11's are issued with passes to do the same.

Every high school in Texas has two police officers allocated to it. They have an office in the admin area and they deal with any criminal misdeeds of the students.

The school has a zone boundary and cannot take students from out of zone without the family following a process which involves the local education office.

There is no 'Sports Academy' as such operating but the individual sports are offered as an option subject in the senior school.
