MESSAGE FROM ASB SPORT / SPECTATOR BEHAVIOUR AT RUGBY GAMES

“Spectator behaviour has become an increasingly topical issue attracting both media interest and community condemnation. The potential damage to secondary school sport needs to be addressed by all stakeholders. It is the responsibility of all Schools to ensure that there is a safe environment provided for all secondary school matches and events. This includes taking practicable steps to ensure match officials and volunteers that attend a secondary school match are protected from physical harm but also verbal abuse. The Auckland Secondary Schools Heads Association is committed to providing a sporting environment in which all individuals are treated with respect. A reminder is also given that any spectator reported by a match referee / umpire to have entered the field of play uninvited at any Secondary School fixture will likely face disciplinary action including sanctions such as the stripping of match points of the team the supporter belongs to.”

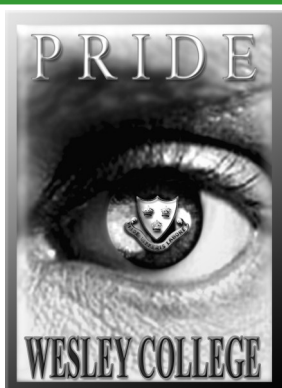
2015 ENROLMENT
