PRINCIPAL'S COMMENT

Enrolments are now open for new students in 2016 .

The Trust Board has approved scholarships for students who are new to Wesley College in 2016.

If you have family or friends who would enjoy the opportunity to study at Wesley College please encourage them to complete an application form.

2016 Principal's Scholarship:

There are up to 9 scholarships available for **top all-round** students **who are new** to Wesley College in 2016.

3 scholarships for Year 9 students and up to 6 scholarships for students in Years 10-13.

The Principal's Scholarship is available to both boys and girls. The scholarship covers approximately 95% of boarding costs.

2016 Day Student Scholarships:

There are up to 10 scholarships available for **top all-round** students **who are new** to Wesley College in 2016.

The Day Student Scholarship is available for boys and girls who wish to enrol at Wesley College in 2016 as day students.

The Day Student Scholarship is worth \$1050 per year.

The Principal's and Day Student Scholarship's are available for up to five years, subject to annual review.

Continuation is subject to good academic performance, exemplary behaviour, and participation in the overall life of the College. Applicants must be New Zealand citizens or permanent residents attending a school in New Zealand.

All students with external assessments will have a three hour formal examination conducted under NCEA conditions.

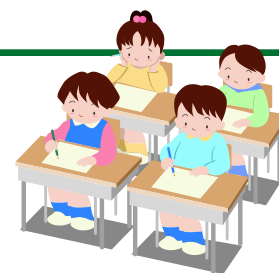
2015 NZQA EXAMINATION FEE REMINDER

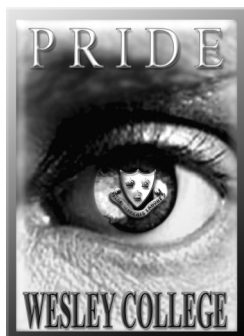
